

Mercer County: Better Together

18-Month Countywide Planning Process (September 2016 – February 2018)

Phase 1 "Lay the Groundwork" (September 2016 - January 2017)

- Project Coordinator hired to lead effort
- Countywide planning teams organized
- Initiative publicized
- Community Network Analysis held
- · Community forums organized
- Community survey developed
- 501c3 application process underway

Phase 2 "Explore Your Community" (February – July 2017)

- Community forum held in each of Mercer County's 11 population centers
- Community follow-ups conducted to reach populations not represented at forums
- All 11 population centers represented on Steering Committee
- Challenge Grant met
- Resident feedback gathered & processed

Phase 3 "Make Decisions" (August - October 2017)

- Through Heart & Soul process, countywide and community statements created using resident feedback
- Countywide summit held to gather feedback on countywide statements, educate residents on the assets of each population center and celebrate progress in the countywide planning process
- Finalized countywide statements serve as roadmap for remainder of planning process
- Community statements & resource toolkit developed, delivered to communities
- Change Over Time & Action Planning Sessions held to help build strategic plan

Phase 4 "Take Action" (November 2017 – February 2018)

- Countywide Action Plans developed around identified priority needs
- Looser-Flake Charitable Foundation asked MCBT Steering Committee to endorse a series of early investment opportunities which surfaced through planning process
- MCBT began transition into community & economic development organization; a central organization identified to accomplish priority work throughout Mercer County
- Board of Directors developed
- Financial commitments cultivated for future sustainability
